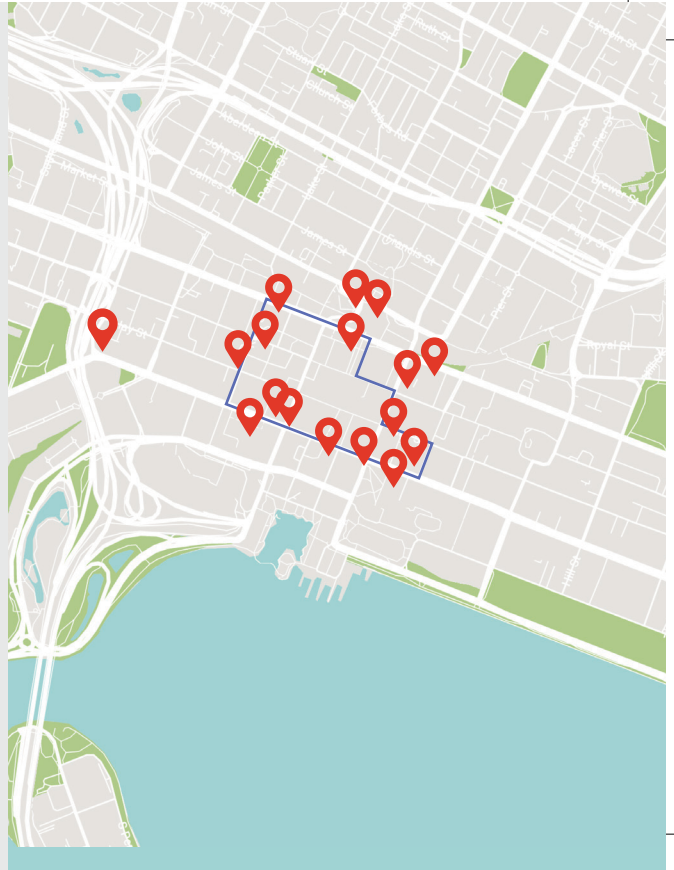
Perth CBD engineering heritage walk
