Greetings, this is the last newsletter before we meet in Seattle, enclosed is the agenda, and proposals for the Annual Delegates Meeting to be held on July 2, 1993. I would like to clarify a few of the agenda items.

NAME CHANGE:

You may suggest different names during the discussion of the change, but we would like to limit discussion time so that we are not meeting all day. Please bring your suggestions to the meeting, but be prepared to be brief. There will be plenty of time for all voices to be heard.

BUDGET

It is the feeling of the current officers that the IAGSDC must have sufficient operating capital to continue to be a part of the larger square dance world. We would like suggestions as to the best way of increasing the operating capital beyond what is now generated by annual dues, banner dances, and tee shirt sales, (note that the tee shirts will be obsolete at the end of this convention). Please be prepared to discuss alternate ways of increasing our revenues. Please note the proposals enclosed with the Agenda. Emergency funding is needed if we are to continue our outreach to the lesbian and gay community as well as to the straight square dance world. Details will be presented at the meeting as to our accomplishments to date and the projected budget needs for the remainder of this year and the 1994 - 95 period.
