
Square Dancing Enthusiasts!!

HOUSING INFORMATION

There are a few important things to know about registering for housing at the convention.

- * **Housing can accommodate 7, 8, 9, or 10 people in a cluster unit. Each cluster unit is comprised of several bedrooms, each accommodating either 1 or 2 people. Each cluster unit shares dorm-type facilities.**
- * **You may choose up to 9 of your acquaintances to join you in a cluster.**
- * **Any persons wishing to share a room or cluster of rooms must submit their applications at the same time.**
- * **All applications for housing must include a check, money order or cashier's check for full payment (see fees below). VISA or MasterCard are also accepted for payment.**
- * **We encourage you to submit your applications as early as possible. No applications will be accepted after June 10, 1993.**
- * **All applications and payments should be sent to the address listed on the application.**

IMPORTANT: Do not send Housing Registrations/Fees to Associated Square Dancers of Puddletown. Send it to the University of Washington address on the form.


Site of the 1993 IAGSDC Convention

Access to the university's intramural athletics building will be available to attendees for \$3.50 per day. The athletics building has an indoor pool, sports courts, full equipped excercise room, and steam rooms.

Be sure to be in touch with Travel Solutions early so they can be start the ball rolling along for you.



CONFERENCE HOUSING POLICY GUIDELINES

Our housing and meal service is offered as a package plan for fixed dates, with an additional daily charge for early arrival and late departure. No credit is given for a shorter stay or missed meals.

Short-Term Housing and Food Services

Delegates living in the residence halls less than two weeks are required to send full payment with their reservation form 21 days in advance of their check-in date to the Housing and Food Services Conference Housing and Special Office.

Long-Term Housing and Food Services

Delegates who are living in the residence halls for a period of two weeks or longer are required to send one-half of the full payment with their reservation form 21 days in advance of the conference to the Housing and Food Services Conference Housing and Special Services Office. The balance of payment will be due upon their arrival at the Conference desk.

LONG-TERM AND SHORT-TERM DELEGATES WHO CANCEL PRIOR TO TWO WEEKS (FOURTEEN NIGHTS) IN ADVANCE OF THE SCHEDULED CHECK-IN DATE WILL RECEIVE FULL REFUND LESS THE RESERVATION FEE.

Cancellations and Refunds

Short-term and Long-Term occupancy: if an individual cancels thirteen nights or less prior to the scheduled check-in date, 10% of the conference's quoted rate for room and board will be retained as a service fee, and the balance will be refunded to the delegate.

No-Shows/Non-Cancellations

Long-Term and Short-Term delegates who do not cancel housing in advance of the scheduled conference date and do not appear for the housing reserved will forfeit 50% of the quoted rate for room and board.

In the event of a cancellation or no-show, the Reservation Fee plus state sales tax will not be refunded.

Method of Payment

Advance payments may be made by check, purchase order, Visa or Mastercard. Checks should be made payable to the University of Washington. If housing is still available for delegates without prior reservations, checks (made payable in U.S. Dollars for the exact amount owed, cash U.S. Currency only: Visa and Mastercard will be accepted at the Conference Desk. Arrangements may be made in advance to accept purchase orders upon arrival.

Accommodations

Residence hall accommodations are convenient to most meeting areas on campus. Many offer lake or territorial views. All rooms have single beds with bedding, towels, soap, drinking cups, and community bath facilities. Most rooms are double occupancy, although some single rooms are available. Attractive guest lounges, meeting areas, and private dining rooms are found throughout the halls. Beds are made and fresh towels provided daily and bed linen is changed once a week.

Token-operated automatic washers and dryers are conveniently located in each residence hall, as well as pay telephones and charge-a-call telephones for long distance dialing. Messages and mail notices will be posted on a message board. Mail for guests is held at the Conference Desk.

All meals are served in a dining hall reserved for conference delegates. Whatever your prearranged board plan may be, you will find a fine selection of carefully prepared items offered cafeteria or buffet style for breakfast, lunch and dinner each day. Choices of entrees, salads and desserts are designed to satisfy a variety of individual preferences.

Our residence halls are designed for adult usage, and our facilities are not childproof. We welcome children who will be supervised at all times. Parents take full responsibility for the actions of their children. Children under nine years of age may bring a sleeping bag to sleep on the floor in their parents' room at no additional charge, and are charged only half the adult food service rate. Those nine years and older must occupy a bed and are charged the full room and board rate. Cots, cribs, or extra bedding are not available.

Limited parking is available for individuals who choose overnight accommodations on campus and prices are subject to change. The charge is \$4.50 Monday through Friday and \$2.25 on Saturday. There is no charge on holidays and Sundays. As you enter the University of Washington entry gates you will pay for the first day. At the check-in lobby desk parking permits may be purchased for the balance of your stay. Please indicate disability parking needs on the reservation form. First priority is given to delegates requiring wheelchair accessibility.

Recreational campers or trailers are not permitted to park on campus or in University parking lots.

Upon receipt of this housing reservation form, the Conference Housing Office will forward a confirmation designating the housing check-in location. Delegates may check in beginning at 2:00 p.m. each day, unless the confirmation card states otherwise.

Check-out time is 11:00 a.m. unless otherwise arranged with your conference.
