The International Association of Gay Square Dance Clubs (IAGSDC), founded 1983, and supports gay and lesbian Modern Western Square Dance (MWSD) clubs worldwide, including the United States, Canada, and Japan. Our organization was formed by and for lesbians and gay men and for their friends. Many gay and lesbian dancers can dance both the man's and woman's parts — you do not have to dance just one part. Gay and lesbian clubs require no special dress code and do not require you to bring a partner.

Membership in IAGSDC clubs is open to all square dancers, regardless of age, race, gender, religion, ethnic background, or sexual orientation. All IAGSDC clubs dance the CallerLab specified levels of MWSD.

The IAGSDC continues to work towards a better more efficient organization that best reflects the needs and wishes of the membership. Several new projects and ideas have been brought forward this year.

Our archivist, Karl Jaekel and Allan Hurst are working together to archive as much of our history as possible (and there is a lot of it). DC Lambda Squares was founded in 1982 and celebrated its Silver Anniversary in 2007. Our members come from throughout the greater Washington, DC, metropolitan area. We hold one club dance per week — meeting every Thursday at 7:30 pm at the National City Christian Church near the Dupont Circle and Logan Circle neighborhoods. In addition to these weekly club nights, most months we also sponsor a Saturday night "Community Dance" at a public school in nearby Silver Spring, Maryland. Friends visiting from out-of-town are always welcome to join us.

DC Lambda Squares hosts two successful fly-ins per year. The "Harvest Festival Hoedown" — begun in 1994 as the "Harpers Ferry Hoedown" — is held each November in the beautiful and close by panhandle of West Virginia and features mainstream through challenge level dancing. Since 2000, the club has also annually hosted "AC-DC" — an advanced and challenge level fly-in held at a convenient location in downtown Washington.

Besides square dancing, the club enjoys a variety of social events including river rafting, ice cream socials, pot lucks, theatre outings, dinners, and sporting events.


