CALLING ALL FOODIES (WINOS TOO!)

Over the next few issues of The Heart Beat, we'll give you a taste of the pre- and post-convention tours we have lined up for you ((and your non-square dancing significant others)!

Grape to Glass Wine Tour (Tuesday, July 2) Limited to 20 people.

Your visit to California wine country starts with a scenic drive across the Golden Gate Bridge to the mouth of the Napa Valley for a stop at the <u>Oakville Grocery</u>, where we'll pick up sandwiches for the trip. Then we'll proceed to <u>Hall Rutherford</u>, one of Napa's newest and most jaw-dropping wineries, for a taste of their wines and tour of how they make them.

Heading further up the valley, we'll stop at Sterling Vineyards, one of Napa's larger wineries, for a gondola ride over the vineyards, up to the winery for tour and tasting. Then we will leave Napa Valley and head west into Sonoma for a visit to the Korbel Champagne Cellars, one of the oldest facilities in the area.

After the wineries, we will take a scenic drive along the coast to historic Petaluma for Dinner-On-Your-Own. After dinner, we'll head back across the Golden Gate Bridge into The City and back to the hotel.

Culinary Factory Tour (Monday, July 8) Limited to 20 people.

Your Gastronomical day starts early with "Breakfast With The Bakers" at the **Boudin Sourdough Bakery** on Fisherman's Wharf. Then we'll head down the Embarcadero a few piers to the **TCHO** (New American Chocolate) Factory on Pier 17, where we will see how they make chocolate! Then uphill to the original Chinatown to see fortune cookies being made at the **Mee Mee Fortune Cookie Shop.**

After our brief visit to Chinatown, we'll drive across town to the <u>Anchor Steam Brewery</u> for a look at the boutique beer

making process. Then we'll grab Lunch-To-Go in Dogpatch, one of San Francisco's newly emerging neighborhoods. Eating our Dogpatch booty on the bus, we will cross the Bay Bridge and head to the North Bay farmlands where we will visit the Jelly Belly Factory and see brewing on a huge scale at the Budweiser Brewery. Then we will head back to San Francisco for dinner at "Technique", the restaurant of the California Culinary Academy.

Satiated and exhausted, we will head back to the hotel

for a good night's sleep.

OUR CALLERS

In this and future issues of The Heart Beat, we'll be featuring the calling staff of **Weave Your Heart in San Francisco**. We start off with our two callers from Chicago.



LYNETTE BELLINI

Lynette is an Advanced and Challenge caller living in Westmont, Illinois, just outside Chicago. Chi-Town Squares is her home club, and she calls C3/C4 and dances with the Importers Square Dance Club, also in the Chicago

area. She's a member of the American Callers Association. This is her first time on the calling staff at an IAGSDC convention, and she is delighted to be coming to San Francisco.

Originally from Long Beach, California, Lynette started square dancing at the tender age of nine years old when her mom made her take lessons. She started calling at age 14, inspired by the sound of the callers she heard, especially Lee Kopman. She learned to dance Advanced to his recordings (though it wasn't called Advanced then – this was in the days before Callerlab and standard levels).

Lynette moved to the Chicago area in 1998. She has written technical articles on square dancing (especially Challenge dancing) and has a series of recordings teaching C4 calls and concepts.

Outside of square dancing, Lynette's interests include gardening, cooking, hiking, both classical and modern electronic music, her cats, and UNIX systems administration.

SAUNDRA BRYANT

A CALLER WHO NEEDS NO INTRODUCTION (at least to IAGSDC conventiongoers), Saundra (Sandie) Bryant is a mainstay of the square dance scene. Sandie lives in the Chicago area and calls all levels through C4. Since

1989 she has been a club caller for Chi-Town Squares, where she currently teaches A2/C1 workshops, and her busy schedule keeps her on the road calling dances all over the country.

Sandie was introduced to square dancing in 1960 by her Girl Scout leader, Swersie Norris, a caller in Chicago's African-American community, and danced with a children's group. Returning to square dancing in 1978, within a year she was dancing at all levels through C4 and called at her first National Convention in 1980. She met her husband Albert at a square dance in 1985 and they have a daughter Alexandra.

Formerly an accountant, Sandie is now a full-time square dance caller and has called in Japan, Sweden, Denmark, Austria and Germany. She is a member of Callerlab and the Gay Callers Association, and is on the staff of AACE (Academy for Advanced and Challenge Enthusiasts). In 2012 she received IAGSDC's coveted Golden Boot Award.

Is she the Good Twin or the Evil Twin? You'll have to come to San Francisco to find out! Just don't call her "Sandra", whatever you do.


