Specialty tips are highly anticipated every year and we've packed the convention with all your favourites!

Look for extras like Take No Prisoners and Hot Hash for experienced dancers as well. All specialty tips can be found in the online schedule on our website.

Bears - For those of hairy disposition and/or large girth, and their admirers. Bare chests recommended. **Bionic** - Dance with others who have had joints replaced. **Contra dance** – Dance in lines with moves similar to Modern Western Square Dancing. If there is a move you don't know, it will be taught. Dance on the hill - After the opening ceremony, make your way to Parliament Hill and enjoy the weather and dance in front of Canada's seat of government. Disco - Dress for disco dancing and enjoy a room of festive lights and fog. GCA - Gay Callers Association callers will start marked hours with a 10-minute tip. Intro - Introduction to square dancing and intro to the next square dance level. Intro to Competition - If you've wondered what competitive square dancing might look like, try this out. Kilt -Opportunity for kilt-wearers to dance together. Leather - Leather dress code requested. Medallion - For new recipients of 10, 20, 25 and 30-year Medallions. Memorial - A tribute to the dancers who are no longer with us. Mobility Challenged - Bring your walker, scooter, wheelchair or cane along with a friend and dance to the excellent calling of Dave Hutchinson who is mobility challenged too! Moonshine - (Un)dress code required; footwear recommended. No phones or photos - bags checked at the door. No entry after doors are locked at 10:10. Please dress appropriately for traveling to and from the dance. Mystery Lyrics - Dancing hour to songs you thought vou knew. Olde Tyme Canadian Barn dance - Traditional square dancing. No experience necessary. Any moves that differ from Modern Western Square Dancing will be taught. **Progressive Squares** - Just after the opening ceremonies, enjoy the magic as the caller directs the dancers to progress from one square to another, around the room, and end up back at home. Women's - For those selfidentifying as women. **Zoom Reunion** – Dance in person with those people you met on Zoom. 70's Hour - Dancing to 70's best music.
