

JoCo Cruise 2019

SAN JUAN LAND CONCERT!

The JoCo Cruise San Juan Land Concert is a time for all Sea Monkeys to assemble in the same place to rock and hang out as one big, warm, fuzzy community.

For those of you who attended JoCo Cruise 2017 or 2018, there are some important differences in the concert plan, so pay attention – there will be a quiz [editor's note: there will not be a quiz]. Anyway, **Here's the Basics....**

Venue: Bahia Urbana (see map)
Doors open at 4pm
Show runs from 5pm - 11pm
BRING YOUR BADGE AND LANYARD

- You must bring your JoCo Cruise badge and lanyard for entry.
- Food and drink available for purchase on site.
- No outside food or drink (water bottle are okay)
- You must be back onboard the Oosterdam by 12:30am for our 1:00am departure.

GETTING TO AND FROM BAHIA URBANA.

To get to the concert venue from the ship, exit the cruise terminal, take a right, and walk along the waterfront. In 5-8 minutes you'll arrive at the Bridge Entrance, which is the only entry point for the land concert. It will open at **4pm**

* You will need your JoCo Cruise 2019 badge and lanyard to enter (your keycard may be used as a backup, but it will slow the entry process, so please **remember your badge and lanyard**

* Only people on our sailing will be permitted onto the venue grounds

* A golf cart will be available for those in need of accessible transport (see "Accessibility")

You may exit Bahia Urbana at any time via the Bridge Entrance, or via the Highway One Exit

** Re-entry to the venue is allowed, but only via the Bridge Entrance*

* You may not enter via the Highway 1 exit at any time

WATCHING THE PERFORMANCE AND RETURNING TO THE OOSTERDAM

The setup will be festival style, with a standing area close to the stage, and seating available along the sides and back. There will also be an accessible seating area near the sound board.

After the last act of the night (They Might be Giants), everyone will need to exit via the Bridge Entrance and/or the Highway One exit. The bridge is relatively narrow, and the ship is very close, so there is no need to feel rushed to return.

Important: As with any time you get off the ship, you will need to show your keycard to re-board. Therefore: Don't lose your keycard!

Transportation:

- * A golf cart will be available for guests who need transport to/from the venue.
- * Rides will be available from 3:45 pm to midnight
- * One shuttle station is outside the secured area at the pier
- * Another shuttle station is located inside Bahia Urbana
- * Look for a person wearing a Yellow Hat with the word "Shuttle"

Restrooms. Accessible restrooms are located:

- * In the brick and mortar building just behind the venue main bar/restaurant area
- * Several portable restrooms will also be accessible and will be marked as such.

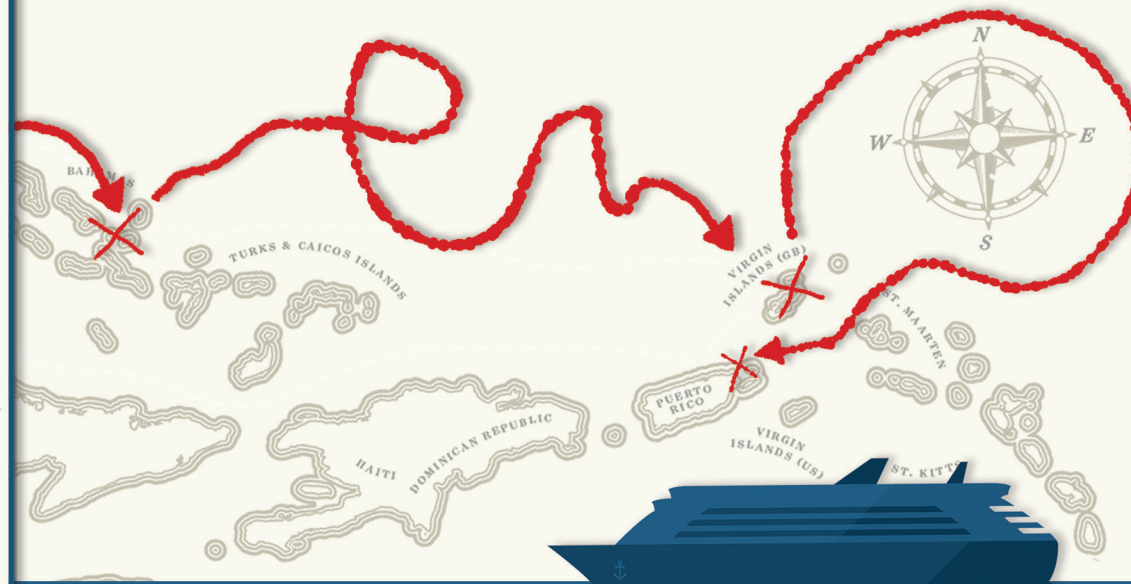
FOOD AND BEVERAGES

- * Bahia Urbana does NOT allow outside food and beverages (water bottles are okay)
