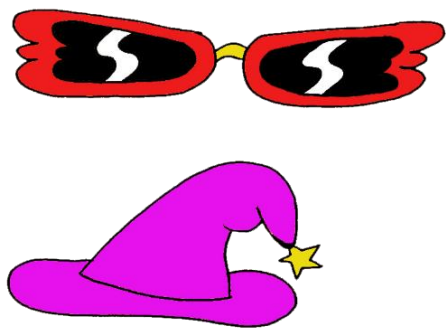
COSPLAY DAY

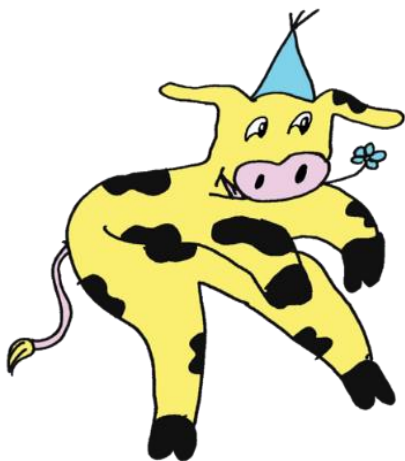


MONDAY IS “MEATLESS”
