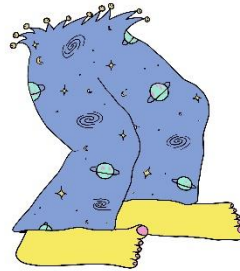

They sure are, Kendall.

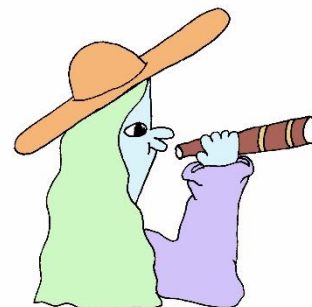
Today in History: March 6
