As per our Bylaws Article II, Section 1, the duties of the State Chair are as follows: The State Chair shall be the chief executive officer of the Party, holding the powers of administration pertaining to the ordinary business affairs of the Party and such other powers as may be delegated by the Board of Directors. The State Chair may appoint such Party functionaries as a recording and corresponding secretary, an office manager, and an events chair. The State Chair shall compile, maintain and make available to the Board of Directors a publication listing all "Standing rules" and "Special rules" adopted by the Board of Directors. The State Chair shall specify the date and time of the next Convention at least 45 days before it is convened. The State Chair, or his or her designee, including other Board members acting within their designated job duties at the direction of the Chair, shall be the person who shall communicate on behalf of the Party. The State Chair shall file any amendments to the Party's Constitution or Bylaws with the Secretary of State within fifteen days after such amendments are adopted.

The Campaigns Director shall also coordinate candidates and campaigns, and assist candidates in navigating compliance with campaign legal requirements and in obtaining campaign volunteers. The Campaigns Director may establish and manage committees (including the appointment of any committee chairs) to perform these and other campaign functions.

This report covers the period running from April 9th to May 4th.

Over the past month I have started speaking with candidates about their races and I attended a candidate training. The candidate training was with Apollo, the LP national candidates chair. I learned a lot and I am working on having him come out to CO to run a training.

I have had two zoom meetings so far with various candidates and had phone conversation and in person meetings with others. I have looked at which races are the most winnable and we are making campaign plans. Other than that it has been a busy month at my job but I should have more free time coming up to work on things.

Affiliates Director Report for May, 2022

The Affiliate Development Director shall develop and support affiliates and development groups, and guide development groups towards official affiliate status. Attended 3 SCRUM meetings.

Sent message to director of the psychedelic decriminalization campaign. In conversation, made loose plans for a meeting about getting LPCO involved. I still need to follow up.

Posted Chaffee County meet the candidates event to LPCO website.

Received email from Chaffee Chair responding to my email from last month saying she is not sure what to do to fix issue with missing petition for charter. I sent email back explaining they can just fill it out now and send it in and an email with document linked. Chaffee Chair emailed that they couldn't get an EIN, because it costs too much money. Also updated that they had been told originally that the bylaws were their charter. I sent email back explaining that we do need the official petition for charter. Also suggested we should talk about EIN, because they shouldn't be charged.

Sent email to Mesa contact to verify event info is correct. Contact responded that event was correct, but updated that until Chair is back from deployment, he is essentially alone.

Sent email to Pueblo affiliate to advise that their events have not been on the LPCO website all year. No response.

Spoke with El Paso Chair in person after last board meeting.

Sent message to Northeast Colorado contact. Confirmed event info is correct and talked about potentially planning an event using LPCO funding.

Emailed Douglas stand in leader to advise that their events still aren't on the website. Received response that their Chair is unavailable so therefore it's my job. I sent email back reminding him that affiliates are responsible for getting their events posted if they want to promote their events.

Sent message to Weld development leader to check if he's still interested. He has taken a step back. While there are a couple active members living in Weld, there currently is no leadership working towards affiliating in Weld at this time.

Sent messages to a couple members living in Boulder County to try to find help to keep the affiliate alive. One of them was willing to help and suggested putting together a call. I sent email to Boulder Chair to see if he would be willing to get on a call with us. He responded that he would and suggested doing the meeting in person.

Attended Arapahoe County meeting.

Attended Denver meeting.

Attended Northern Colorado meetup. One of the people there showed interest in potentially being the new Chair for the Larimer Development Group.

Attended Jefferson County meeting. I let them know their monthly meetups were not posted on LPCO website.

Attended Adams County Development Group meetup. One of their regulars volunteered to be the Treasurer, but they are wanting to get a few more regulars before affiliating. Discussed planning an event for July using funding from LPCO. Plan is to hold an event at a restaurant, advertise by all possible means, potentially even mailers, provide free food.
