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The Feds have rules about everything, including who can advertise in a political party newspaper. You might think the First Amendment permits you to advertise anywhere for any purpose, and it should, but it doesn't. So...

Who can advertise in *LP News*?

- Individuals can advertise.
- You can advertise your business too, but only if the ad is paid for by an individual.
- Organizations can place ads if they are FEC-filing entities.

If you want to promote yourself, an idea, a business, or an organization that files with the FEC, then buy an ad in *LP News*. Doing that will promote both your purpose and the LP with one action.

If you meet the criteria and want to advertise, here are the costs. Our readership is 10,000 people strong, and growing...
