Aloha,

On May 25, 2026, the LNC voted to disaffiliate the Libertarian Party of New Hampshire in a session lasting under thirty minutes, without prior notice to the affiliate, without a list of charges, and without any investigation. This was done despite the LNC's own established framework which has previously committed the national party to formal investigation, evidence review, reasoned analysis, and enumerated findings before intervening in any state affiliate's affairs.

LPNH has formally appealed following the notice of revocation, and the matter is now before the Judicial Committee. The attached amicus brief asks state affiliates to weigh in because the precedent affects all of them. If the LNC can revoke an affiliate's status at will, based on general impressions rather than specific findings, then no state party's affiliation is secure and the procedural commitments affiliates have relied on for years are meaningless. The brief asks affiliates to defend the principle that [Article 5, Section 6 of the national bylaws](#) requires disaffiliation for cause, with notice and fair process, and to urge the Judicial Committee to either reverse the disaffiliation or order a Dixon-style investigation, the same remedy the LNC rejected on the floor.

This goes in lock-step with our resolution to protect affiliate free speech and due process rights.
