Motion by Andrew Kolstee to **authorize an expenditure of \$30.16 to Kolstee Media to renew the domains (www.chautauquaLP.org and www.freechq.org)** was seconded by Pat Peterson and passed by voice vote.

Len Morlock will work on the letter to recruit candidates and edit what has already been written. Petitioning begins on Tuesday, April 18, 2023.

Andrew Kolstee noted that the next meeting will be the 100th business meeting of the Chautauqua County Libertarian Party. He has heard no news from the See-Zurh House regarding plans to reopen. If no location is settled by April 20 or 21, 2023, it was agreed that the May meeting will be set at the Lakeview Hotel and Restaurant in Mayville.

Andrew Kolstee suggested that the Western New York Libertarian Parties should plan a summer picnic.

Len Morlock attended the Western New York Freedom Seekers meeting. The status of third parties was discussed.

Andrew Kolstee noted that Larry Sharpe has started his Full Sharpe tour for 2023.
