Motion by Andrew Kolstee to **accept the Treasurer's report** was seconded by Bob Peterson and passed by voice vote.

Chair Bob Peterson opened nominations for the position of Chair. Bob Peterson nominated Andrew Kolstee and he accepted the nomination. The nominations for Chair were closed. **Andrew Kolstee was elected Chair** unanimously over NOTA.

Chair Bob Peterson opened nominations for the position of Vice-Chair. Andrew Kolstee nominated Bob Peterson and he accepted the nomination. The nominations for Vice-Chair were closed. **Bob Peterson was elected Vice-Chair** unanimously over NOTA.

Chair Bob Peterson opened nominations for the position of Secretary. There were no nominations for Secretary. Motion by Andrew Kolstee to **leave the Secretary position vacant until it can be filled** was seconded by Bob Peterson and passed by voice vote.

Chair Bob Peterson opened nominations for the position of Treasurer. Pat Peterson nominated Andrew Kolstee and he accepted the nomination. The nominations for Treasurer were closed. **Andrew Kolstee was elected Treasurer** unanimously over NOTA.

A tribute was given in memory of Len Morlock. Pat Peterson said a prayer, which was followed by a moment of silence.

The next meeting and election night party is scheduled for Tuesday, November 5, 2024 at 7:00 p.m. at Shawbucks in Jamestown.
