MEETING SUMMARY May 20, 2025

Date and Time: Tuesday, 20 May 2025 at 4:30pm Mountain time

The meeting was called to order at 4:36pm Mountain time.

Records of Previous Meetings: The minutes of the 6 May meeting were approved without objection.

Storing/Shipping Material from Headquarters: Caryn Ann reported that the headquarters building has been sold. There was discussion of what material remains in the building and who might be able to help us move it out. Caryn Ann said Susan Hogarth is willing to make one trip for this purpose but has only a small car; Caryn Ann will advise her regarding the highest priority items, ask her to take just samples from any literature supplies, and ask her to use her judgment regarding anything else she may find if she still has room in the car.

Categories: In response to a question about how to categorize images of conferences and groups of people, Caryn Ann repeated her request that nobody categorize anything until she is done with the rebuild project. She noted that the image tag template allows for tagging any number of individuals, and that there is a category for "events" that can be used for conferences.

Site Technical: There was discussion of issues relating to file references, including the difference between "File:" and "Media:" and the extent to which such references are being done via templates, vs. directly which might mean a lot of work if we need to change how they are done. Andrew noted that references to files are showing up via the "what links here" feature, even if not in the file info page.

General LPedia: Caryn Ann asked Andrew to create an article for the Bylaws Committee. She reported that currently only a small fraction of new account requests are legitimate.

Alabama: Sam reported that this weekend is the state party's 50th anniversary; he has been going through boxes of historical items and will be posting some of them.

New York: Andrew said he has decided it will be better to sort the papers he has into archival boxes before continuing his scanning of them. He said he found the press release announcing adoption of the porcupine.

Nolan Archive: Andrew said he expects to be in D.C. this August and plans to see if he can get access to some of the things that were not scanned.

Facebook Live Videos: James said he plans to try finding some of these to download by following links to Facebook groups that exist on LPedia.
