MEETING SUMMARY June 17, 2025

Date and Time: Tuesday, 17 June 2025 at 5:30pm Mountain time

The meeting was called to order at 5:39pm Mountain time.

Records of Previous Meetings: The minutes of the 3 June meeting were approved without objection.

Templates and Categories: In response to a report about a formatting problem that arose when the MediaNewTab template was used with a date on the same line, Andrew found that there was an extra character in the template and fixed it. In response to a report that appropriate categories were not being generated for "Local" conventions, Andrew found that a template was treating "County" and "Local" conventions differently and fixed that. James reported that he added links from his personal article to some images that previously had nothing referencing them.

Site Technical: Sam said that MyWikis made an update to the content-type for PDF files so that they will now display, rather than just being downloaded; this means that the indirect references via Google Docs that had been put in place for some such files are no longer needed.

Site Statistics: Sam said Google Analytics has now been turned back on, and overall traffic looks similar to what it had been previously. The most-referenced article in the past two weeks was the investigatory report about Angela McArdle. He said the next most referenced thing was an "access forbidden" page, which he suggested may indicate that somebody has been trying to hack the site, but James noted that he

ends up with such a page whenever he tries to access the site using Opera on his phone. Sam said he would look into that.

Featured Article: Joe reported that the featured article has been updated as discussed at the last meeting.

Donations: Caryn Ann reported that there may be a problem with how donations are being handled, as her monthly donation is either not going through or is not being credited as intended.

Uploading Projects: Andrew reported that he has uploaded more minutes from North Carolina and is gradually working on ones from various other states. Sam said that he will start working again soon on uploading in general. Andrew said that he has uploaded 400-500 files from the Nolan collection since he started working on that.

Convention Memorial Committee: Lisa said she has a backlog of about ten people for whom she needs to create articles, and that she hopes to be able to use another blog post to solicit more information for this project.

Facebook Live Videos: Andrew said he ran into a problem with the script he has been using, which has meant he can only download a few videos at a time. On the other hand, he has also found that the videos he wants to download don't seem to be being deleted as quickly as he expected.
