PARTY HISTORICAL PRESERVATION COMMITTEE

MEETING SUMMARY July 15, 2025

Date and Time: Tuesday, 15 July 2025 at 7:30pm Eastern time

Where: Online: Zoom

The meeting was called to order at 7:33pm Eastern time.

Records of Previous Meetings: The minutes of the 7 July meeting were approved without objection.

Site Technical: Sam said the "access denied" problem reported by James has happened to at least one other person; he will continue to look into it.

Site Statistics: Sam reported that some of the most-accessed articles recently were our agenda, the 1980 national Platform, the 2026 convention, and the Colorado bylaws.

Featured Article: It was suggested that the article about Ed Clark be made the featured article.

General Committee Business: There was discussion of the recent LNC meeting, where the subject of appointing a new chair for our committee had been on the agenda but they did not get to it. Caryn Ann said she expects them to act on removing her and making an appointment at the August meeting.

Storage Unit: Caryn Ann said there are still historical materials at her house that she needs to bring to the storage unit and some of her things that she needs to take out, but she won't be able to do this immediately due to personal issues. So she plans



to keep the key until she is actually removed from the committee, but at that point she will send it to us.

Nolan Archive: Andrew said he had uploaded some more material. He mentioned that he came across a manuscript of a historical novel that Nolan had written, which he doesn't intend to upload because it doesn't really pertain to the LP but he will include a note about it somewhere.

LP HPC YouTube Channel: Joe reported that he discussed with Caryn Ann the fact that multiple people could be given access to upload videos, and he plans to go over the procedure with her, but they have not yet had a chance to do that. It was agreed without objection that any member of the committee who wants that access should be given it.

Facebook Live Videos: Andrew reported that he thinks he tried to download all the existing videos that he had identified as priorities, but he needs to go back and retry some that failed. He said we need to come up with a method for identifying new ones as they are created, as the new ones will only be online for a short time.

Meeting Schedule: There was discussion of alternative times and committee members' preferences. It was agreed without objection to try meeting at 5:30pm Eastern going forward.
