MEETING SUMMARY August 5, 2025

Date and Time: Tuesday, 5 August 2025 at 5:30pm Eastern time

The meeting was called to order at 6:21pm Eastern time.

Meeting Schedule: Caryn Ann moved to change the regular meeting time to 4:00pm Mountain time; the motion passed without objection.

Vice Chair: Caryn Ann moved to appoint Sam Bohler as Vice Chair; the motion passed without objection.

Records of Previous Meetings: The minutes of the 15 July meeting were approved without objection.

Material from Headquarters: Caryn Ann reported that Barbara Howe had delivered to her the material that Susan Hogarth had been able to retrieve from the headquarters building; Caryn Ann will be moving it into the storage unit. The material that Steve Dasbach retrieved is still at his house.

Site Statistics: Sam reported that some of the most-accessed articles recently were about appeals of resolutions, the 2026 convention, and the LP of California. He will try to have some traffic statistics that can be compared over time by the next meeting.

Site Technical: Sam reiterated that the issue of file pages not showing from where they are linked relates to use of the MediaNewTab template; Caryn Ann suggested

we stop using that template. Sam reported that the "access denied" problem is resulting from MyWikis blocking access from old versions of certain browsers. James expressed concern that this means some people can't access the site. Sam noted that although there do seem to be a lot of accesses being blocked on this basis so there probably are some actual users being affected it may be that most of them are actually bots.

Featured Article: Ed Clark is now the featured article.

Storage Unit: Caryn Ann reported that she removed some sorting racks that belonged to her and for which there is no longer room.

California: Joe reported on the recent state convention at which an almost entirely new Executive Committee had been elected, including himself as Northern Area Coordinator. He said he expects to be making a lot of updates to California-related pages as a result of the convention and because there are things that had not been kept up-to-date during the past term.

LP HPC YouTube Channel: There was a continuation of the discussion from the previous meeting; Caryn Ann said she thinks she will be able to give access to those who need it.

Nolan Archive: Andrew said he has now gone through 6.08% of the PDFs.

Facebook Live Videos: Andrew again suggested we maintain a schedule of state conventions as a tool for finding new videos in time to download them before they get deleted.
