## PARTY HISTORICAL PRESERVATION COMMITTEE

MEETING SUMMARY      September 2, 2025

The meeting was called to order at 6:08pm Eastern time.

**Records of Previous Meetings:** The minutes of the 5 August and 19 August meetings were approved without objection.

**Templates:** Caryn Ann noted that there is no "state template" for DC; Andrew said he would look into it.

**Storage Unit:** Caryn Ann reported that the button cases needed attention – they got "jumbled" and the velvet has deteriorated – so she brought them back to her house to work on them.

**California:** Joe reported that they will be repopulating the state HPC.

**New York:** Andrew reported that he added information about Don Silberger who died recently.

**Convention Memorial Committee:** Caryn Ann moved to appoint Lisa Gansky and Susan Hogarth as co-chairs of this subcommittee and to grant them authority to add other members as they see fit; the motion passed without objection. Lisa will focus on making LPedia updates while Susan will make arrangements for a presentation at the convention. There was discussion about what information should be added to



LPedia about the committee itself, and people who have been memorialized in the past.

**Facebook Live Videos:** Andrew said he knows that some videos have been deleted, and that it would be good if somebody could be looking for them every month. Caryn Ann said this would be a good task for a new volunteer but it seems that not many people are volunteering for the LP right now.

**Templates (continued):** Caryn Ann asked about unexpected behavior from the MediaNewTab template when she tries to use it with a description of "pending"; Andrew said this is a result of the way he had to change it to make the file usage list work.

**Site Statistics:** Sam reported that during the period 19 August through 2 September there were 1400 active users, and characterized this as pretty normal.

**Meeting Schedule:** There was discussion of switching to a monthly schedule, since things seem to be going pretty smoothly. Caryn Ann noted that we can always have an extra meeting if something urgent comes up. Caryn Ann moved to hold future meetings on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of each month; the motion passed without objection.
