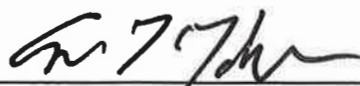
KNOW ALL BY THESE PRESENTS:

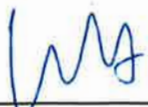
Whereas, the above named plaintiff has duly applied to this court for an Injunction against the defendant in this action, according to the statute in such cases provided.

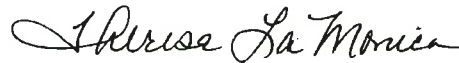

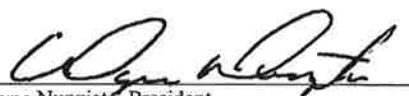
