

Dear Judicial Committee:

Thank you for honoring my previous request to provide a copy of the Kosin Appeal and timeline through [LPedia](#) early AM today. Given that sustaining members are prospective respondents and are afforded the same rights as the LNC participate in this appeal, members require additional time than what has been afforded by this committee. I respectfully request this committee reschedule its hearing to a later date to meet the minimum seven-day notice requirement provided in the Judicial Committee Rules of Appellate Procedure 4.1.

In addition, I respectfully request as a prospective respondent a copy of appeal signers to review for myself whether this appeal has met the bylaws (Article 7, Section 12) requirement to be heard by this committee.

In support of this request for the hearing to be rescheduled, I state the following:

1. The Kosin Appeal was submitted on January 6, 2025.
2. On January 28, 2025, I made an email request to this committee for a copy of the Kosin Appeal and schedule which this committee would hear the appeal (see below for a copy of said email).
3. This committee published to LPedia a copy of the Kosin Appeal and hearing schedule this morning at 04:35, 29 January 2025 and amended the post a few minutes later at 04:52, 29 January 2025. All times are UTC on LPedia.
4. This committee has called for a hearing date of Sunday, Feb. 2, 2025, at 9:00-11:00AM Eastern Time.
5. This committee's notice for its hearing is four days, counting from today to Saturday. See Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised 12th Edition sections 9:4, 9:14(2), 56:34.
6. All Libertarian Party members are considered prospective respondents under Judicial Committee Rules of Appellate Procedure 1.4. The decisions of this committee will affect all members.
7. This committee is required "within seven days following receipt of such petition(s)" to "provide a copy of the petition(s) and any supporting material to each prospective respondent, along with notice that any desired responses are due in writing **within seven days**" per the Judicial Committee Rules of Appellate Procedure 4.1 (**emphasis mine**).
8. The hearing date establishes the deadline for prospective respondents to submit to this committee any petition, response, amicus brief, or supporting material which "must be received **prior to the hearing** to be considered as part of the case" per Judicial Committee Rules of Appellate Procedure 9.1 (**emphasis mine**).
9. Filings submitted after the hearing (Feb. 2, 2025) are not considered to be part of the case.
10. Since notice of the hearing was provided today, this committee is providing four days of notice in violation of the Judicial Committee Rules of Appellate Procedure 4.1.

In support of this request for a copy of appeal signers, I reincorporate the paragraphs 1-10 from above here and state the following:

11. The Kosin Appeal does not include a statement describing how it met the bylaws (Article 7, Section 12) requirement to initiate the appeal which requires “ten percent of the delegates credentialed at the most recent regular convention or one percent of the Party sustaining members” to join.
12. The Kosin Appeal argues that its signers too are a matter of consideration for this committee to consider stating:

“The signatures for all these appeals have not only exceeded both thresholds, but were reached in 48 hours (with the potential exception of the Phillies appeal about which I have little knowledge on his signature gathering). This is unprecedented and shows a deep discontent in the Party with members turning to you to control an LNC that is out of touch with its membership and doesn’t listen to their concerns.”

13. Upon information and belief, the Kosin Appeal does not meet the bylaws (Article 7, Section 12) standard to initiate the appeal.
14. The committee turning over the list of signers for review will not prejudice the appeal but instead ensure that the “unprecedented” signature gathering effort was accomplished properly and in doing so protects the due process rights of members.

I respectfully request that this committee consider this request in the best interest of members and this committee.
