RE: AMICUS OF JAMI VAN ALSTINE RE: DELETION OF PRIOR PUBLIC LIST

Appellee: Libertarian National Committee (LNC)

Jurisdiction: LP Bylaws Articles 7.12 and 8.2

Bylaws Alleged to be Violated: Articles 7:14, 7:15, 13, and 16 (incorporating RONR)

Relevant RONR Provisions: Will be cited throughout as needed

Interested Parties: LNC and every national Libertarian Party Member

This brief Amicus is submitted to provide further support for Ms. Robson's arguments that the deletion of the previous Google Groups archive constitutes a violation of the Party Bylaws, which I believe warrant independent consideration. The pertinent section of the Bylaws states: [emphasis added]:

LP Bylaws 7:14

14. The Secretary or a designee shall promptly post notice for each session of the National Committee; any National Committee proposed agendas; and approved minutes of each convention and open National Committee session to **a permanent archive section on the Party's website**. Any person may record the National Committee's proceedings while in open session, or subscribe to a read-only email list on which National Committee votes are recorded.

Proposed agendas and notices were consistently shared through that email list. Deleting it—or even after a restoration—without ensuring a link is available on the Party website for members to find violates this Bylaw, which implies a need for permanence. Clearly, deletion undermines that principle of permanence.
