

## Wayne County Pioneer # 15

*Archibald Howe (1772-1827)*

Archibald Howe was born in 1772 in Frederick County, Maryland. He married Elizabeth Sivers. Elizabeth Sivers was born in 1774.

The will of Archibald Howe was written 17 April 1827 and probated 17 April 1818. His wife, Elizabeth was the executor of the estate. The witnesses were John Dawson and Stephen Fisher. The appraisers were John Harter, Fred Dage, and Henry Evey. The will of Archibald Howe listed the children as:

Archibald Howe died 25 November 1827 at the age of 73. His wife, Elizabeth died in 1848. Both are buried at the Hoover-Swagler Cemetery in Milton Township, Wayne County, Ohio.

Archibald Howe was listed in the 1826 Wayne County Tax List in Milton Township, Wayne County, Ohio. He owned 2 horses and 2 cows. He owned twenty acres of property valued at \$40 in the south part of the southwest quarter of section 13 in Milton Township.

Archibald and Elizabeth Howe were entered in the Wayne County Pioneers in 1986.
