Nicholas Hofstetter (1799-1891)

Anna Moser (1802-1891)

Nicholas Hofstetter was born 24 June 1799 in Langnau, Bern, Switzerland. He was the son of Johannes Hofstetter (1766-1857) and Catherine Zuercher Hofstetter (1766-1861. Nicholas Hofstetter married twice. The first time he was married to Anna Wahli. They married 13 January 1821. Anna was born about 1799 and died about 1830. To this union, four children were born: Jacob (1821-1824), Johannes (1823-1899), Johannes (1825-1911) and Elizabeth (1827-1912).

Nicholas Hofstetter's second marriage was to Anna Moser. Their children were:

Peter N. (1832-1919) Katherine (1834-1908) Barbara (1836-1930) Anna (1838-1919) Jacob (1839-1902) David (1842-1896) Magdalena (1844-1917) Abraham (1846-1872)

Nicholas Hofstetter died the 16 March 1891.

In 1830 he purchased part of the northwest quarter of section of section 22 in Sugar Creek Township, Wayne County, Ohio from Peter Hofstetter.

Anna Moser was born 2 September 1802 in Ruderswill, Canton, Bern, Switzterland. She was the daughter of Jacob Moser (1770-1824) and Magdalena "Mattie" Overholt Moser (1772-1832). She married Nicholas Hofstetter in 1828 in Ohio. Anna Moser Hofstetter died 21 August 1899 in Dalton, Sugar Creek Township, Wayne County, Ohio. Her estate was probated in 1899 in Wayne County, Ohio.
