Adam Rumbaugh (1793-1870)

Adam Rumbaugh was born 22 April 1793 in Northampton County, Pennsylvania. His parents were David Rumbaugh (1766-1847) and Anna Maria “Mary” Hartzel (1771-1842). Adam married Elizabeth Lauffer on the 3 March 1815 in Northampton, Pennsylvania. Their children included;

Adam with his wife Elizabeth Lauffer and two children Isaac and John came to Wayne County in March of 1819. He was a farmer and a member of the Lutheran church. He donated land for the Rumbaugh Graveyard. His son John was the first child buried there. Adam died 20 August 1870 and was buried in the Rumbaugh Cemetery in Chester Township, Wayne County, Ohio.

On 19 October 1816, Adam purchased 160 acres of land in the northeast quarter of section 8 of Chester Township, Wayne County, Ohio. He was listed in the 1820 US Census for Chester Township and in the 1826 Wayne County Tax List. In 1826, he owned 2 horses, 3 cows, and 160 acres of property in the northeast quarter of section 9 valued at \$392.

Adam Rumbaugh was entered in the Wayne County Pioneers in 1987.
