Philip Arnold Jr. (1778-1858)

Philip Arnold Jr. was born 1778 in eastern Pennsylvania. He married Catherine Slough, daughter of Leonard Slough of Northampton County, Pennsylvania. Philip Arnold came to Wayne County bringing eight of their twelve children.

The known children of Philip and Catherine Slough Arnold are;

Philip Arnold Jr. and his family were early settlers of Plain Township, Wayne County, Ohio. They later moved to East Union Township, Wayne County, Ohio where the extended family lived for four generations. Philip and his wife Catherine and their son Jacob and his wife Nancy are buried at the East Union Lutheran Cemetery.

Philip Arnold's will was written 1 December 1848. It was probated 27 November 1858. His wife Catherine was listed. The following children were listed: Jesse, Thomas, Samuel, William, Daniel, Jacob, Hetty Westenhaffer, Hannah Hines and Anna Fagley. The following grandchildren were listed: Lovina and Sam, children of Charles (deceased); Philip, William, Anna, Jon, Sam, Thomas, J, Jacob Robison, children of Eliza Arnold Robison (deceased); and Philip Arnold.

In 1821, Philip Arnold bought 80 acres of property in the eastern half of the northeast quarter section of 32 in Plain Township, Wayne County, Ohio. On 5 of August 1819, Philip purchased 160 acres in the southeast quarter section 28. On 7 October 1818, he purchased 160 acres of northwest quarter of section 28, both in Plain Township. Philip was the assignee (2nd owner) of the property in section 28.

Philip Arnold Jr. was entered in the Wayne County Pioneers in 1987.
