Jacob Seifried (1782-1864)

Jacob Seifried was born 12 March 1782 in Westmoreland, Pennsylvania. He was the son of Sebastian Seifried. He married Barbara Hare the 29 April 1806 in Westmoreland, Pennsylvania. Barbara Hare was born 1 August 1785.

It is unknown how many children were born to this union, however after Barbara death on the 23 July 1856, Jacob sold his land in 1859 and went to live with his son John Seifried in Wabash, Indiana. Barbara was buried at the Oak Hill Cemetery/Wooster Cemetery in section 3. Barbara died at the age of 70 years old. Jacob Seifried died the 17 January 1864 in Pleasant, Wabash, Indiana.

On 18 September 1813, Jacob Seifried purchased 160 acres in southwest quarter of section 32 in Wayne Township, Wayne County, Ohio. Jacob Seifried was listed in the Benjamin Douglas's History of Wayne County, Ohio as one of the first settlers of Wayne Township, Wayne County, Ohio.

Jacob Seifried was listed in the 1826 Wayne County Tax List in Wayne Township, Wayne County, Ohio.

Note: Spelling of the surname was found as Sifert / Seifriet.

Jacob Seifried was entered in the Wayne County Pioneers in 1988.
