Charles Kelley (1754- 1847)

Charles Kelley was born about 1754 in Baltimore, Maryland, an early settler of East Union Township, Wayne County, Ohio. Charles Kelley married Geminah Crownover.

Charles Kelley died in 1847. His administration of his estate was dated 28 May 1847. The papers show the names of Thomas Kelley, Joshua Kelley, Sam Lorah and George Larue.

Geminah Kelley died in November 1855 at the age of 65 years. She was buried at the Stauffer Farm Cemetery.

Charles Kelley purchased two tracts of land. On 27 September 1811 Charles Kelley purchased 160 acres southwest quarter of section 5 in East Union Township, Wayne County, Ohio. He purchased 80 acres on 23 October 1813 the northwest quarter of section 5 in East Union Township, Wayne County, Ohio. He was listed in the 1820 Wayne County Census and the 1826 Tax List.

Charles Kelley was entered in the Wayne County Pioneers in 1994.
