Jacob Hay (1777-1850)

Jacob Hay was born the 30 March 1777 in Somerset County, Pennsylvania. Jacob married Mary Elizabeth Laud. She was born in 1788, the daughter of Jacob Laud and Eve Shaver. Jacob and Elizabeth had a son Simon.

Simon Hay was mention in Chancery Records of Holmes County, Ohio (Vol. 10 p. 446) that stated that Jacob went before a Justice of Peace, James Hanna, and that he deeded his land to his son, Simon and his heirs. Jacob died the 28 January 1850 in Millersburg, Holmes County, Ohio.

Jacob Hay had a Saw Mill on Paint Creek built about 1825.

Jacob Hay purchased 160 acres of land on 7 November 1815 in the northeast quarter section 11 in Franklin Township, Wayne County, Ohio. He also had purchased land earlier in section 9 in Prairie Township, Wayne County, Ohio. He was listed on the tax list for 1814,1819 and1820. Later he was listed with 80 acres of school lands in section 16 of Prairie Township, Wayne County, Ohio.
