

## **Wayne County Pioneer # 57**

*Conrad Haverstock (1755-1830)*

Conrad Haverstock was born about 1755, a native of Switzerland. He came to America with his parents who settled in the state of New York, subsequently moving to Tuscarawas County, Ohio in 1812, and moving to Paint Township, Wayne County, Ohio in 1817.

Conrad Haverstock married Margaret Richard of Bedford County, Pennsylvania. They had ten children as said in the Ben Douglas History of Wayne County, Ohio. Conrad Haverstock was a member of the Lutheran Church. He lived on the farm in Paint Township where he settled and died in his 75<sup>th</sup> year 1830. He was buried at Mt. Eaton Cemetery, Paint Township, Wayne County, Ohio.

Conrad Haverstock purchased 160 acres in the southeast quarter section 8 in Paint Township, Wayne County, Ohio on the 21 June 1814. He was listed in the 1820 Tax List of Wayne County Ohio. Conrad Haverstock was listed in the Wayne County Quadrennial Census of the years of 1819 and 1823. Conrad Haverstock was listed in the 1826 Tax List of Wayne County, Ohio.

The Abstracts of Conrad Haverstock estate # 183, Journal 4 p. 332 was dated 20 March 1830.

Conrad Haverstock was entered in the Wayne County Pioneers in 1996.
