Solomon Bonewitz (1796-1876)

Mary Stecher (1816-1894)

Solomon Bonewitz was born the 12 January 1796 at Stephens Neck, Beckley, Virginia (now West Virginia) and was the fourth son of Jacob Bonewitz. Solomon Bonewitz died the 7 January 1876 in Ft. Wayne, Indiana.

Soloman Bonewitz married Mary Stecher on 2 September 1823. Mary was born in 1816 in Pennsylvania. She died the 15 December 1894 in Indiana. Solomon Bonewitz moved to Congress Township, Wayne County, Ohio where he held township offices as treasurer in 1828 and 1829 and trustee several years. He was a Justice of Peace in 1852.

Solomon and Mary Bonewitz had twelve children:

Solomon purchased 160 acres of the northwest quarter of section 20 in Congress Township, Wayne County, Ohio. He farmed until 1866 when he with his two youngest sons and families moved to a farm near Fort Wayne, Allen County, Indiana. Solomon Bonewitz and wife Mary Stecher Bonewitz died in Indiana and are buried at Antioch Cemetery, Hoagland, Indiana. James Criss owned the homestead in Wayne County until 1876.

William Swartz was born 27 February 1820, Bedford County, Pennsylvania coming to Wayne County with his parents in 1831. He died 23 October 1908. To this union eight children were born, four son and four daughters. Family burials were at West Salem, Congress Township, Wayne County, Ohio.
