James Goudy (1772-1823)

William Goudy (1786-1837)

James Goudy was born about 1772. He married Mary Cook before coming to Wayne County. James Goudy was at the St. Clair's defeat 4 November 1791 and was wounded in the thigh with a bullet he carried in his body and ultimately caused his death. Mary Cook Goudy died on the 30 March 1810. James and Mary had eight children with some of the children born in Pennsylvania. The children were as follows:

William; James; Sylvanus; John; Lydia; Mary; Hannah and Rebecca. James Goudy purchased six parcels of land in Sugar Creek Township, Wayne County, Ohio.

- (1.) 13 December 1813 160 acres southeast section 13
- (2.) 8 March 1814 160 acres south part of northeast section 17
- (3.) 8 March 1814 160 acres of southeast section 18
- (4.) 8 March 1814 160 acres of southwest section 18
- (5.) 21 March 1814 160 acres of northwest section 17
- (6.) 8 March 1814 160 acres of northwest section 18

James Goudy death occurred in Dalton on 6 September 1823. He was a miller. His estate settlement was recorded in Journal 3, p. 137 on 26 September 1823 in Wayne County.

James Goudy was listed in the Wayne County 1817, 1820, and 1826 Tax List and the 1820 US Census for Sugar Creek Township, Wayne County, Ohio. James Goudy was listed as the third person living in the county.

William Goudy son of James was born 1786. William Goudy married Sarah Bates in Stark County, Ohio. William most likely built the first mill soon after his father's death since it was erected about 1823 on his land in section 13. The mill was built of logs and was driven by water onto an overshoot wheel from two streams and two dams. The mill ran for many years. Description of the old mill was highly prized by the pioneers of how it separated the flour from the grain into two grades.

William Goudy died 21 April 1837 at Mt Eaton, Wayne County, Ohio. His wife Sarah Bates Goudy died 26 December 1860 aged 70 and buried in Dalton. William Goudy's Administration of Estate was 9<sup>th</sup> May 1837
