### *Samuel Youngs Case (1796-1870)*

Samuel Youngs Case was born 22 September 1796 in Sussex County, New Jersey. He was the son of Augustus Case Sr. The family came to Plain Township, Wayne County, Ohio. He married Jane Akright the 20 August 1817 in Plain Township, Wayne County, Ohio. He was a farmer and a member of the Methodist Church.

Samuel Youngs Case died 7 April 1870. Jane died the 15 January 1876. Both are buried at the Maple Grove Cemetery in Plain Township, Wayne County, Ohio.

Samuel Youngs Case purchased 80 acres in the East ½ of the southwest quarter section 27 on January 1821 in Franklin Township, Wayne County, Ohio. Samuel Youngs Case was listed in the Wayne County 1826 Tax List and the US 1820 Census.
