Jacob Philip Smith (1800-1884)

Jacob Philip Smith was born 20 March 1800 in Steubenville, Jefferson County, Ohio. Jacob Philip Smith was the son of Philip Smith II (1761-1838) and Agnes Waits Smith, submitted # 5 Wayne County Pioneer. He married Rebecca Miller 13 June 1822 in East Union Township, Wayne County, Ohio. Rebecca Miller was born 22 November 1801 in Washington County, PA. Jacob P. Smith was recorded in the 1820, 1830, 1840 census of Wayne County. He purchased 80 acres of property from his parents on the 14 April 1829 in Wooster Township, Wayne County being the southwest quarter of the east half of section 25. About 1852 Jacob P. Smith traveled west to Indiana and was recorded in Adams Township, Cass County, Indiana in 1860. By 1880 census he was recorded with a daughter and son-in-law John H. and Mary Shipe.

Jacob Philip Smith died the 24 August 1884 in Wayne Township, Noble County, Indiana. Burial was at Fairfield Cemetery in Fairfield Township, Dekalb County, Indiana. His wife, Rebecca Miller Smith died 12 May 1888 in Noble County, Indiana.
