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SUGGESTIONS

IN REGARD TO

THE MANNER OF USING THIS RECORD.

This Record was prepared for the convenience of the Township Clerk in preparing a record of his transactions under the Soldiers' Relief Law, in the most simple and concise manner possible.

The manner of using the Record is as follows:

1st. Upon receiving from the County Auditor the "Disbursing List" of names of parties to whom relief has been awarded by the Relief Commission, enter said list as follows:

In the first column headed "Name of Person" enter the names of the persons to whom relief has been awarded.

In the second column enter the amount allowed per month, provided the same amount is to be paid them each month, which will of course be the case unless the Auditor's list shows that it is to be paid in UNEQUAL monthly installments.

If ordered paid in unequal installments (that is different amounts in different months), place on the line opposite the name, the amount to be paid each month as specified, in the proper column headed Jan. Payment, Feb. Payment, etc. Then when the order is issued for the amount of any monthly payment, put down in Red ink the number of the order just above the amount, as the horizontal ruling is made wide apart to admit of doing so.

The same plan can also be adopted for those whose allowance is the same amount each month, and then if carefully kept up the Red ink entries will always show who have drawn their allowance in each month and will refer to the order book in case of any question, the stub of which will show the signature of the person who drew the order if the stub is properly signed, as it should always be.

The law also provides "that when said commission is satisfied that any person entitled to relief under this act will not properly expend the amount allowed, it may appoint a suitable person to draw and expend the same in such manner as said commission may direct." If therefore the Auditor's list shall show that the Relief Commission have so directed that the allowance to any party shall be paid to some other person, enter the name of the person so named by them in the column headed for that purpose.

We think that the use of this Record as indicated above will simplify the keeping of the accounts under this Law, and reduce the work connected with it to a minimum.
