Explanation of Use of This Book.

The new Revised Statutes of Ohio require as follows:

SEC. 581. Every Justice of the Peace, when commissioned, shall, in thirty days thereafter, transmit the date thereof, to the Clerk of the Township, who shall make an entry thereof in a book by him to be provided for that purpose, and before the first day of September of each year, the Clerk shall give a written notice to the Trustees of all commissions expiring within twelve months after the first day of November following, or which may have expired theretofore, and the date when each such Justice's commission expired, or will expire, and the Trustees, on receiving such notice, shall notify the electors of such Township to elect at the next regular November Election thereafter, a Justice of the Peace to fill each vacancy, in the manner pointed out in Section five hundred and sixty-seven (567).

SEC. 567. When a vacancy occurs in the office of Justice of the Peace in any Township in the state, either by death removal, absence at any one time for the space of six months, resignation, refusing to serve, or otherwise, the trustees, having notice thereof, shall, within ten days from and after such notice, fill any such vacancy by appointing a suitable and qualified resident of the Township who shall serve as Justice until the next regular election for Justice of the Peace, and until his successor is elected and qualified; and a majority vote of the Trustees shall be sufficient to appoint.

At the next regular election, some suitable person shall be elected Justice in the manner provided by law, for the term of three years; and the Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas, in certifying to the secretary of state the appointment of a Justice of the Peace to fill any vacancy, as aforesaid, shall specify in his certificate, the name of the Justice of the Peace whose place is supplied by the person whose appointment is certified to, and also the date when such vacancy occurred; and to enable the Clerk of the Court to comply with so much of this section as relates to his duties, the Trustees shall notify him of any vacancy, as aforesaid, and the date when it occurred; and in case the Election of an additional Justice of the Peace in any Township is authorized by the proper authority, the Clerk of the Court, in certifying his election to the secretary of state, shall state in his certificate that he is such additional Justice of the Peace, so authorized and elected.

PART 1 of this book contains the blank forms for recording dates of commissions according to law. The forms have the same general wording as the date upon the Governor's commissions, so as to be a complete and legal record.

At the bottom of each record page is a blank for recording the date of giving notice to trustees of expiration of commission which, if always filled out, will show that the notice was given at the proper time, as required by Section 581 of the Statutes.

PART 2 contains the notices to trustees when justice's commission will expire, which are to be filled out and torn out of the book and sent to the trustees as required by law.

PART 3 contains the notices required to be sent by township trustees to Clerk of Court of the county, and also a memorandum of the time of sending. (See latter part of Section 567.)

These notices are to be torn out and sent to the Clerk, leaving the stub in the book to show that the notices was sent as required by law.

PART 4 contains the notices or advertisements to be set up in THREE public places in the township. Each time a Justice is to be elected, THREE of these are to be torn out and used, which notices must be given at least ten days before election.

PART 5 consists of blank ruled pages for recording the time when the notices were set up, or anything else connected with the matter, of which it is desirable to have a minute.
