Bible contained a newspaper clipping, an Obit: data given "Christopher Columbus Myers, was born in Westmoreland Co., Pa., April 1, 1831 and fell asleep at his home in West Salem, Ohio, Dec. 21, 1905. At age of two he moved to Wayne County, Ohio with his parents.

Sept. 25, 1853, he married Elizabeth Talley. Moved to Hancock County, Ohio, followed his trade as blacksmith and manufacturer of tools, Two and one-half years later returned to Wayne County and settled in the old homestead in Killbuck Valley, near Armstrong Station, where he lived til 1881, whence he moved to Ashland County, near West Salem In later years he lived in West Salem, Wayne County, Ohio. He was father of 8 children, 3 daughters, 5 sons, one daughter died in infancy.

Sons:- Will died Sept 4 1886 in Idaho; Marion, resided in Seattle, Washington; George, in Medora, N. Dakota; Edd in Dickinson, N. Dakota; Joe on the home farm; Mrs. Naftzger near West Salem; Mrs Hefs(? believe its Hess) in Ashland.

Was a member of Zion Chapel U.B. Church.
Funeral Held M.E. Church West Salem, Ohio conducted by Rev. Jennie Metsker."
